

DASSAULT IS BULLISH ON INDIA

Dassault Aviation presented its Falcon fleet of large cabin, long range business jets. Among them were Dassault's 5,950 nm/11,000 km range Falcon 7X trijet, and the 4,000 nm/7,700 km Falcon 2000LXS, a short-field derivative of the popular Falcon 2000. Dassault is the Indian market leader in the large cabin, long range aircraft segment, with 22 aircraft currently in service and several more on order. Most new orders are for longer range Falcon models like the

Falcon 7X and Falcon 8X that are capable of flying non-stop to London City Airport from anywhere in India.

Eric Trappier, Chairman and CEO, Dassault Aviation, said, "For the moment, overall business jet demand in
